

The following message is from Slippery Rock Campground. **Notice of EMERGENCY REPAIRS to the WATER PLANT:** Potable water is a requirement for a campground. It is vital to everyday existence. The aging infrastructure in the park's water plant has finally given way and there are extensive emergent repairs that require immediate attention. What parts of the existing water plant that are barely functioning must be shut down completely to allow the contracted vendors to disassemble, remove and prepare the water plant building for overhaul. The entire water processing operation will be upgraded to meet current standards and provide the park with potable water for many years to come. The projected start date for this work is January 15, 2023 with an expected completion date of March 31, 2023. **What does this mean for the Membership?** At or around the 15th of January – the Board has asked for at least 1 weeks' notice. The water will be shut off to the entire park with the exception of the lavatories in the Rec Hall. There will not be access to showers or laundry facilities during this time.

The Board of Director's in conjunction with Park Management have determined the best course of action is to stop overnight stays during this time (~1/15 to ~3/31).

Members are permitted in to the park during the day to check on their lots and campers/trailers. Please understand that these steps are necessary and we all deeply apologize for any inconvenience.

With all the conversations on Facebook, we felt we should get this Notice out to you now. It is important to understand the Board of Directors made a good decision to do this now. They are being pro-Active so we will be able to stay open. If we would lose our water midseason, the DEP would require we close. It would be much worse to have to close for the whole season. We do not want that to happen We appreciate your patience and understanding.
